

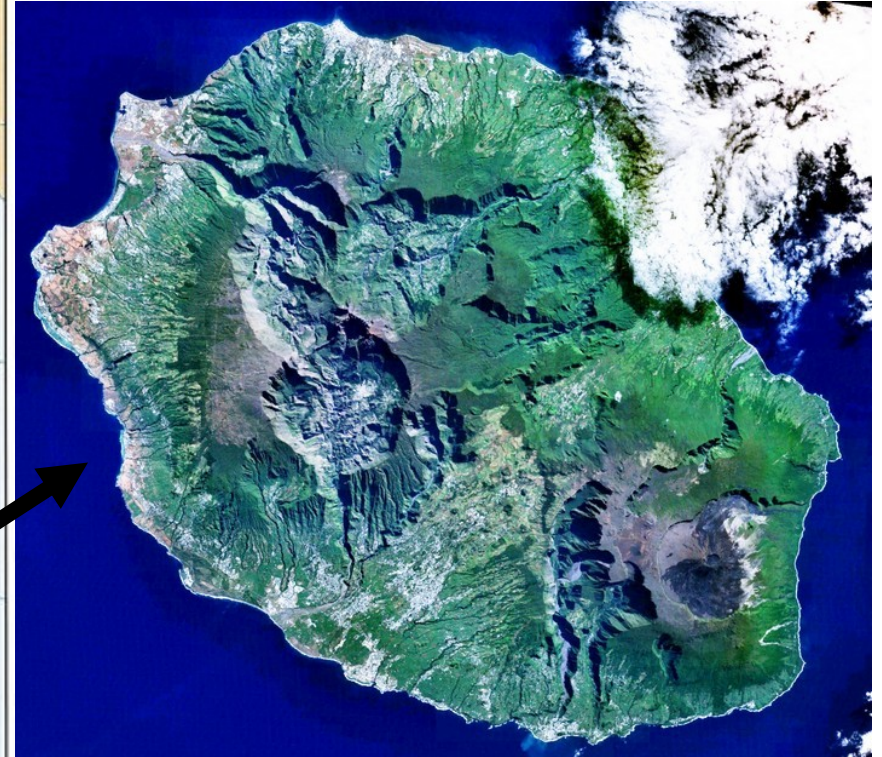
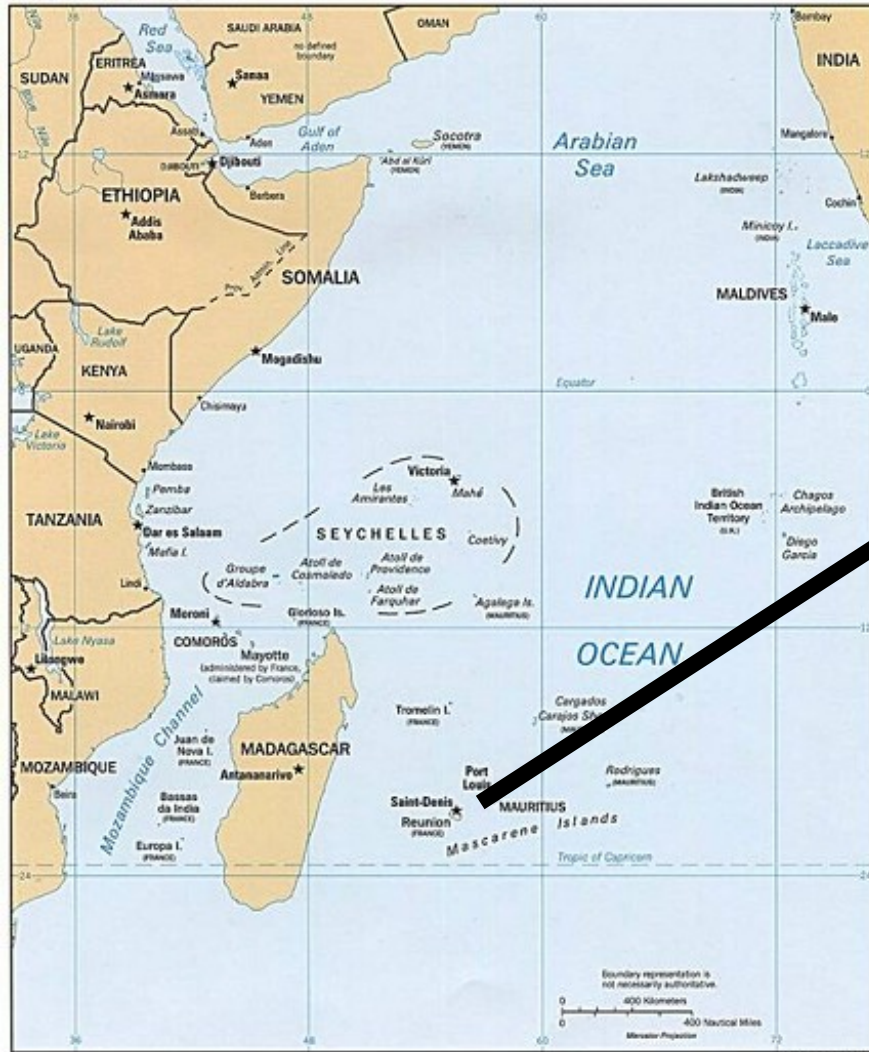
# Introduction to Réunion Island

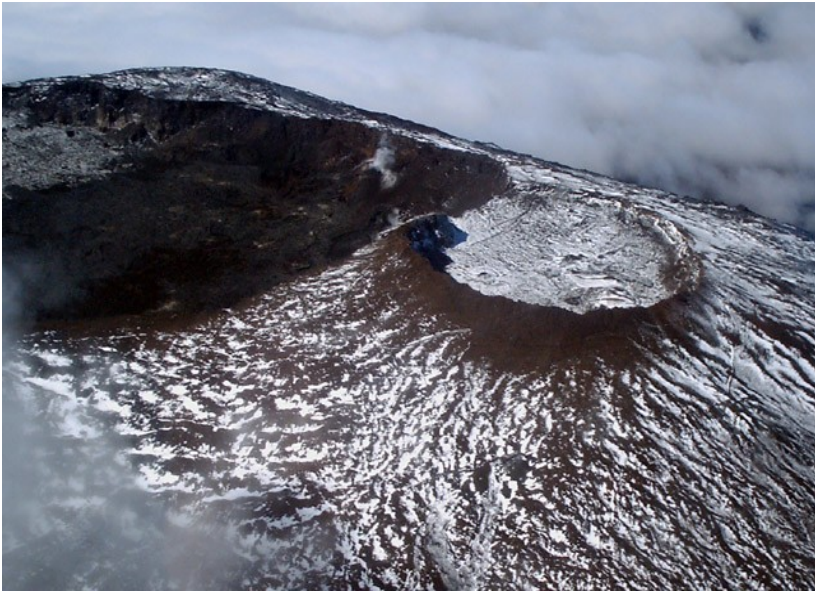

# Volcano : Piton de la Fournaise

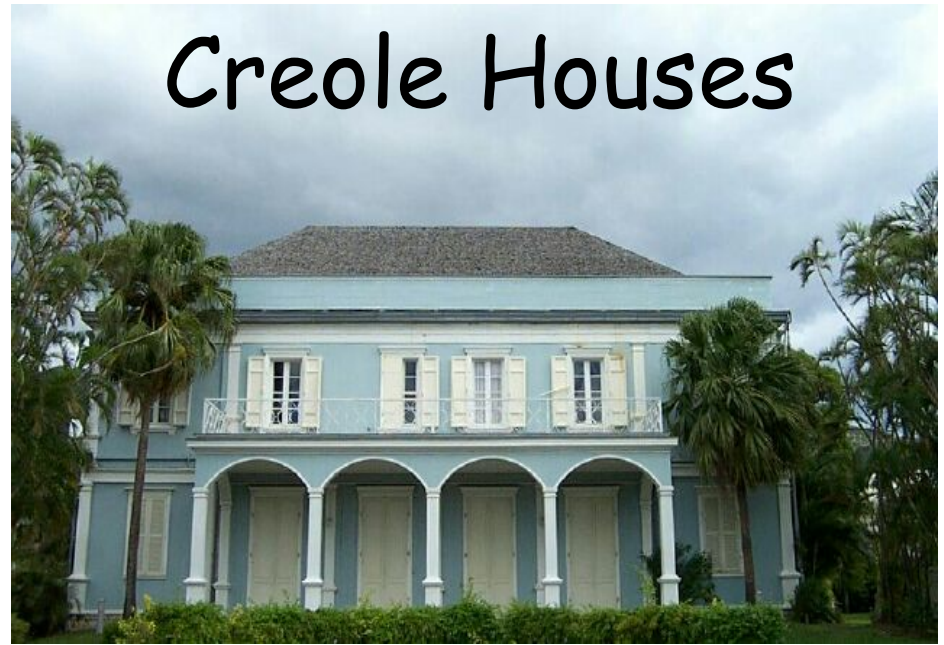


For 10 years , the volcano has thrown up lava every year.

Local food blend influences from Africa, India, China and Europe.

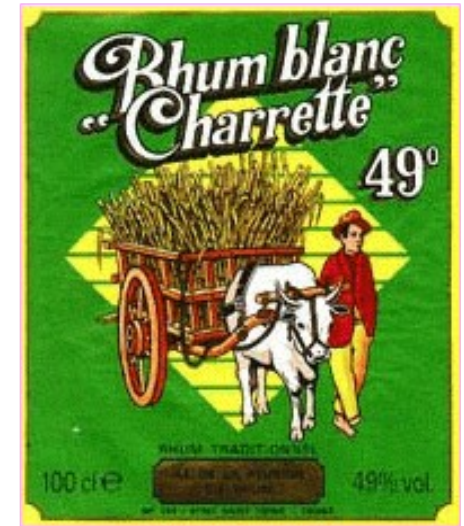
